

WILD DOG CREEK RETREAT ACCOMMODATION



Welcome to Wild Dog Creek Retreat, located on Wurundjeri-willam land in Nillumbik. We respectfully acknowledge the traditional owners of this land and the elders, past, present and emerging.

Wild Dog Creek Retreat offers peaceful accommodation in a glorious bush setting, just over an hour's drive northeast of Melbourne. You will need to be able to negotiate steps to access the house and the areas within it, as it is split level. There is a resident cat who is not allowed in the bedrooms, but pack your antihistamines if you have a cat allergy.

Living:

The living space is shared with your host. Glorious views from the living-dining area invite you to stop and absorb the sunset, and you are most welcome to sit back and relax in front of the fire on chilly evenings. A kangaroo mob grazes in the paddock just off the surround deck on most evenings; king parrots, rosellas, galahs, and corellas turn up for morning seed, and small honeyeaters flit about in the bushes around the house.



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Bedrooms:

Your accommodation is a private bedroom in the host's home, each room with its own view from picture windows, and a desk. You will share a bathroom with other workshop participants. There is one queen bedroom, one double bedroom, and one double futon room. Beds are all fitted with electric blankets and natural fibre bedding.



Dress:

Comfortable and practical is the order of the day. It can be cold up here, so bring warm clothes, slippers or thick socks, and dress in layers.

How to get to Wild Dog Creek Retreat: 300 Wild Dog Creek Road:

Wild Dog Creek Rd is 3.1 km northeast of the St Andrews pub corner / Eltham turnoff on the Hurstbridge-Kinglake Road. After you pass the Mittons Bridge Road turnoff on the left, you will come around a corner and see 60 kph speed signs. Put your right indicator on straight away, as the Wild Dog Creek Rd turnoff is immediately after the speed signs and easy to miss. The road is gravel and should be driven slowly to avoid animals that often jump out in front of the car, including on the property itself.

Number 300 is 2.8 km from the turnoff, almost at the end of the road. Follow Wild Dog Creek Road all the way along the creek until it turns to go up the hill. **DO NOT** turn right up Dinsdale Rd, whatever your sat nav says. Follow Wild Dog Creek Rd up the hill and around the bends. The corrugations on the big hill are annoying but brief.

The driveway entrance is on the right at the crest of the last hill, the second last drive on the road. Take the right-hand fork in the drive, pass the car port, and park next to the

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wire fence. The path to the house is between the carport and the fenced area. The entrance door is on the side of the house nearest the path.

Tariffs:

Bed only: \$105.00 per night. \$15.00 for an additional person sharing the room.

Continental breakfast Muesli, fruit, sourdough bread / toast, tea, plunger coffee:
\$15.00 per person extra.

Linen: BYO sheets, pillowcases, towel, face washer, to reduce the laundry burden on our tank water. If it is not practical for you to bring your own linen or you forget to pack it, you may hire a linen pack of 2 sheets, 2 pillowcases and 1 towel from here for an extra \$20.00.

We provide: Duvet, duvet cover, pillows, electric blanket, extra blankets, bathmat, hand towel.
